<p>July 2021 note: The proposal is to install a new stained glass window in the western most window of the south aisle. The window currently contains plain glazing which is in need of repair. The artist is a local glass maker who designed and fabricated two small windows for the porch. It is understood that the DAC accepted the principle of the porch windows on the basis that they were small and in an ancillary space.</p> <p>No objections to the proposal have been received from the statutory consultees and the parish has been advised to consult the local planning authority with regard to planning consent. The subcommittee were supportive of the principle of the proposal to replace the existing plain glazing with a stained glass design. While acknowledging that the design has the support of the local community, the subcommittee had reservations about the quality of the proposed design. However, given its location at the west end of the church, it was agreed that the impact on the significance of the church would be minimal.</p> <p>July 2021 minute: The committee resolved to issue a <i>Not Object</i> Notification of Advice subject to the following provisos:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The design of the window is revised removing the cross from the second light. This could be replaced with a single dove flying up or similar. The revised design to be agreed with the DAC subcommittee prior to fabrication of the glazing. • The parish is encouraged to consider employing a more traditional font for the text which would be easier to read. • Specification and schedule of works for the repairs to the window masonry to be submitted to and approved by the DAC subcommittee in advance of work commencing on site.

<p>July 2021 note:</p> <p>The PCC have been considering their options for replacing the heating installation for several years. Air, water and ground source heat pumps have been considered as well as oil or gas fired boilers. An initial site visit, attended by the diocesan heating adviser (GO) and the CBO, was made in March 2020 after which the initial proposals were revised based on a gas fired boiler with additional radiators, trench heating and a few fan convectors. Once the more controversial elements of the initial proposals were revised, such as the reduction in the number of proposed fan convectors, GO was content that these proposals should be progressed.</p> <p>Following this meeting, the PCC approached Electric Heating Solutions who put forward proposals to install eight “Couronne” infrared chandelier heaters in the arches of the nave with under pew heaters provided in the chancel and two portable infrared heaters in the tower. GO has been consulted and considers the</p>						

proposed chandeliers rather ugly and that they are, in her opinion, fairly ineffective. The parish have provided a list of other Grade I and II* listed churches where the heaters have been employed and have contacted parish representatives for their views on the effectiveness of the system. Positive responses have been reported.

The CBO has consulted the Registries of the diocese where these have been installed requesting copies of any judgements which may have been written when the faculty applications were considered. Consultation responses are awaited from the CBC, Historic England and SPAB. The parish contacted Historic England directly and a site visit is being arranged which will include GO in her role as HE Senior Building Services Engineer.

Points for consideration:

- Whether the proposed chandelier heaters are appropriate in the context of the Grade I listed church.
- Whether the DAC would support the installation of this type of heater, generally, and, if so, in what context they would be considered appropriate.

July 2021 minute:

The following comments arose from the DAC’s discussion of the proposed chandelier heaters:

- The committee had concerns that the heat provided by the chandelier heaters will be inadequate and ineffective in such a large space. Those sitting in the aisles will receive heat from one direction only with body heat being lost to the cold masonry of the external walls and large areas of glazing. It is unlikely that the heat from the units will warm the feet and legs of those sitting in the pews.
- The proposed units will be highly visible and were not considered appropriate within the setting of the Grade I listed church.
- The red glow emitted when in use will detract from the character of the church and is not welcomed by many including wedding photographers who would be likely to ask that they are turned off.
- Heating in the chancel is not addressed by the proposals. The proposal to install infrared under pew heaters is not acceptable as it would be likely to damage the choir stalls.
- Infrared will heat any surface which has a direct line of sight so the chandeliers in the eastern arches could cause thermal cracking in wood of the highly significant chancel screen.
- It appears that the proposal is based on economy only.

The DAC resolved to await the pre-application consultation response from Historic England and Church Buildings Council following the August site visit before sending their advice to the parish.

<p>July 2021:</p> <p>In summary, Jill Woodward churchwarden has requested an in-principle view from the committee for this proposal prior to commencing the project. Further clarity and more detailed information has been requested, but was unavailable prior to distribution of the agenda. We hope to receive this in time to present at the meeting. For the past fifteen years Jill and a group of volunteers have sewn covers for the kneelers and would like to continue this community work with the introduction of a wall hanging on the south wall of the church, taking inspiration from the two existing stained glass windows. With the support of the PCC they are keen to continue their work as a team to bring colour to the church.</p> <p>The case officer recommends a not object NOA to be issued.</p> <p>For discussion and an in-principle view.</p> <p>July 2021 minute:</p> <p>The committee were unanimous in their support of the concept of the wall hanging. During the discussion the following observations were made, in order to help the parish develop their design moving forward with the project:</p>			

- **Imagery** - the reasoning behind the depiction of the Ascension of Christ is apparent, in reflecting the stained glass altar window, the committee raised concerns that the human form can prove challenging to replicate in cross stitch and suggested that if the parish wished to pursue this it would be helpful to produce a sample piece of embroidery prior to commencing the larger work. The parish should also consider whether it is appropriate to depict Christ as a Caucasian. Alternatively, locally relevant imagery and similar designs used in the cushions could be used.
- **Size** – ideally the tapestry should be subservient to the existing stained glass windows in the church and the size should be reduced. Large enough to have the desired impact, but not so large as to detract from the historic windows.
- **Colour** - more vibrancy in the colours of the thread being used would be welcomed, to mirror the strength of colour in the existing stained glass windows.
- **Fixing** – Rather than a permanent fixture the committee suggested it would be more appropriate for the tapestry to be hung as a banner. This would offer the flexibility to replace the piece should the parish decide to embroider another at a later date.

The parish have received the above guidance and were very grateful for this early stage advice from the committee. They are continuing to work on their design with the DAC textile adviser Suellen Pedley.
