- Final budget expenditure plans presented to November Synod for approval

What's happening Nationally?

2021 Year to Date (July):

All Dioceses

- Average change in cash receipts for 2021 vs same period a year ago: -4.4%
- (Highest diocesan change: +6.9%, Lowest diocesan change: -18.5%, but this diocese has received half its requested share)
- No. of dioceses receiving more cash 2021 ytd vs 2020 ytd: 8 out of 40 (20%)
- Average change in cash receipts for 2021 vs same period in 2019: -10.5%
- (Highest diocesan change: +0.4%; Lowest diocesan change: -24.1% but this diocese has received half its requested share)

Northern Province

- Average change in cash receipts for 2021 vs same period a year ago: -3.2%
- No. of dioceses receiving more cash 2021 ytd vs 2020 ytd: 3 out of 11 (27%)

Southern Province

- Average change in cash receipts for 2021 vs same period a year ago: -4.7%
- No. of dioceses receiving more cash 2021 ytd vs 2020 ytd: 5 out of 29 (29%)
