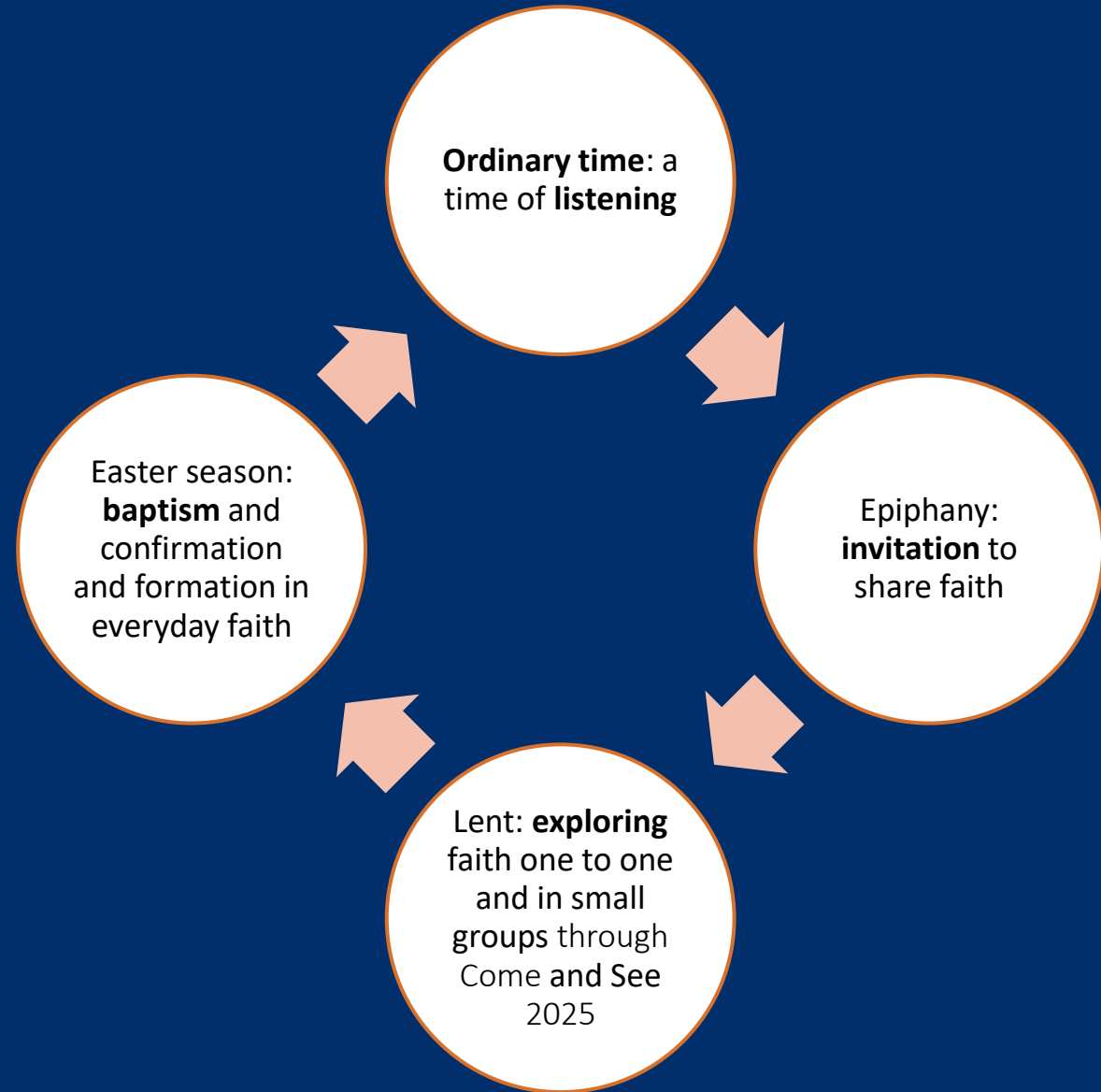
How do we meet Jesus and how does

Does it work?

Over 3,000 individuals took part in 2025, and 140 leaders used Come and See in their parish

- *62% email open rate throughout Lent – our biggest active audience to date*
- *80% said they'd receive the emails again*
- *Small groups are held in churches, schools, prisons, home and youth groups, and online*
- *40% of small group leaders had someone considering baptism by the end of Lent*
